This Bulletin updates the general SE Covid Regulations with specific information for participants in the Women's Softball European Premiere Cup 2021.

Last updated: August 10, 2021

Travel:

Leaving Home country:	Exit requirements determined by home Government. This is under the whole responsibility of travelling Teams / individuals.
Arrival in Host Country:	<p>Please check all details carefully before leaving the Home Country.</p> <p>Before traveling to the Italy, foreigners traveling must, according to the ordinance of 29 July 2021, all teams' delegations' members must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be in compliance with the green certification (https://www.salute.gov.it/portale/nuovocoronavirus/dettaglioNotizieNuovoCoronavirus.jsp?lingua=english&menu=notizie&p=dalministero&id=5531) • fill out the digital Passenger locator form (https://www.salute.gov.it/portale/nuovocoronavirus/dettaglioContenutiNuovoCoronavirus.jsp?lingua=english&id=5412&area=nuovoCoronavirus&menu=vuoto&tab=11) <p>Also, for the same ordinance, all teams' delegations' members can enter in derogation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • With a COVID test (PCR or antigen) in the 48 hours prior to departure. • Filling out the Passenger Locator Forum (https://www.salute.gov.it/portale/nuovocoronavirus/dettaglioContenutiNuovoCoronavirus.jsp?lingua=english&id=5412&area=nuovoCoronavirus&menu=vuoto&tab=11) • Upon arrival in Italy, delegations must retake the COVID test by the organizing company, at a cost of 8 euros per person, for this purpose we will organize a stand at the palafeste in via Cividale next to the softball field, after 15.30 on Sunday 15 August. Other details will follow. <p>After this test the teams will enter the bubble, and nothing else will be required.</p> <p>All the Teams have to stay in a dedicated area on the field for meals.</p> <p>To speed up the procedures, it is necessary to receive the list of people part of your delegation by Friday, August 13, 2021.</p> <p>Athletes can enter derogations (Deroghe - Covid-19 - Viaggiatori (salute.gov.it)), with a COVID test negative certificate in Italian or in English taken in the 48 hours prior to departure, and filled in the Passenger Locator Forum.</p>

Transportation:

Teams:	Restrictions by transportation in own / rented vehicles Teams are responsible for their own transportation throughout and are advised to make full use of disinfectant wipes pre- and post- travel, and suitable mask discipline within their vehicles.
Officials:	Restrictions by transportation in own / rented vehicles are in Organization responsible.

Testing:

Testing regime:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 48 Hours before entering the Host Country: negative antigen or molecular test. The negativity certificate is needed either in English or in Italian. • Before the TC meeting: antigen test financed by each team (at a cost of 8 euros per person). The details of the arrangements will be communicated by the organizer (it is necessary to send to Maurizio.rizzi@yahoo.it and segreteria@whitesoxbuttrio.it the list of people part of each delegation by Friday, August 13, 2021.) • No other testing is required. <p>If testing is needed to enter the Home Country: contact the covid officers.</p>
In case of a positive test:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to the entrance in the Host Country: the person shall not travel to the event. • In the Host Country: the positive person will be isolated and tested 72 hours after the first positive test. <p><i>It is advisable that the teams agree with the hotels upon a 'isolation room' for potential positive person.</i></p>

Bubble arrangements:

Hotels:	It is all Teams' responsibility to be aware of their accommodation's rules, and to comply. IF Teams share Hotel with Officials there must be no contact between individuals from each group unless absolute necessary, and then only with 2m distancing, with masks.
At venues:	Team Covid Officers are responsible to Event Covid Officer for Team members complying with all venue distancing regulations. Mask obligation in every place outside and inside the field
During games:	Balls will be cleaned / administered by the UiC / TC
