All but three tournaments have their organizers for the upcoming softball season in Europe confirmed.

While **Italy** and **the Czech Republic** will, as usual, take care of a number of events each, there are also some newcomers when it comes to organizing countries: **Croatia** (Zagreb), **Germany** (Berlin), and **Hungary** (Budapest). After a one-year break, Bulgaria is also back on the list.

Not to forget - Prague and Havlíčkův Brod, Czech Republic will host the **WBSC Men's Softball World Championship** in June (13 - 23).
